This year, five SCF members attended the Courant3D Festival in Angoulême, among them François Serre, its organizer. More in in this issue.

This Festival is as an unmissable annual event for immersion and 3D. The eclectic and universal program of films, animations and conferences puts us at the forefront of international cinematographic, visual and stereoscopic research in light of current societal concerns.

In recent years, we have seen many movies on ecological and post-apocalyptic themes. This year, most were on t Al: Al survival in a world where humans had disappeared, humans fleeing in distress in a virtual world created by Al, fantasy of Al's ability to feel emotions, Al's ability to make unprogrammed decisions, Al's ability to deceive us. Al materializing human intellectual approaches, some of a philosophical-psychiatric nature that were difficult to understand, but also high quality videos designed by human intelligence and even beautiful ones entirely created by Al.

Al remains a tool whose result depends on the creator. Nowadays most 3D effects are now produced by 2D/3D conversion, with or without Al,. Fortunately we were also able to appreciate beautiful videos in 3DS images from stereo shots.

Let's not forget the participation of our members in other 3D events: the Nouvelle-Aquitaine group meeting in Blanquefort, Les Regards du Sud (Édouard Barrat), the REG'ART festival in Gruissan and the Photomage festival in Arcachon (Benoît Gaubert).

Enjoy your reading, and see you in Angoulême in 2025.
